**ADDENDUM NO. 2

The following clarifications and changes shall be made to the Specifications and Contract Drawings:

I. PROCUREMENT AND CONTRACTING REQUIREMENTS

- A.** These documents were required by the Federal agency providing partial funding of this project. This agency as present does not have standard procurement contract documents and requires the use of documents typical to a construction contract. All bonding requirements listed in these documents must be met. In any document where substituting the word for “procurement” rather than the word “construction”, clarifies the intent of the document will be considered applicable. Construction licensing requirements are not applicable. Complete every document with all information typically available to a manufacturer
- B.** DELETE Page 3 from EJCDC C-410, Bid Form for Construction Contracts and REPLACE with the attached Page 3.1.

II. SPECIFICATIONS

- A.** Bidders are bidding on the manufacture and supply of the booster pump station per Specification Section 33 14 45 and applicable sections. Other specifications detailing site and similar work are included for information only and apply to work performed by the owner.
- B.** Section 33 14 45, COKE OVEN PREFABRICATED PUMP STATION & GENERATOR, Section 2.02 PUMP STATION ENCLOSURE, DELETE Paragraph H and REPLACE with the following:

“H. Exterior Walls - The exterior walls shall be suitable for attaching a “faux” mountain rock siding similar to the existing pumpstation’s rock exterior shown below. Exterior siding panels to be overlapped and installed with appropriate self- tapping fasteners with integral gaskets, and shall be removable without any disturbance to interior panels. Butted seams are not allowed. All openings in walls are to be structurally framed, sleeved, trimmed, and provided with external drip caps. Repair or replacement of exterior panels must be able to be done entirely from outside. Base Bid will be without the supply of the “faux” mountain siding and the Additive Alternate will be the additional cost of supplying the pump station with the finished “faux” mountain siding.”
