Contractor is fully responsible for ensuring sealed bid is delivered to Cleveland Utilities by the closing date and time.

The Project consists of the painting of various rooms, equipment, and appurtenances inside the Cleveland (Water Treatment) Filter Plant and other miscellaneous modifications and repairs.
