(local time), August 25, 2020, and then at said office opened and publicly read aloud. Contractor is fully responsible for making sure sealed bid is delivered to Cleveland Utilities by the closing date and time.

The project consists of furnishing and installing the following elements: installation of 1,130 linear feet of 12-inch ductile iron-pipe, construction of a 500,000 or 600,000 gallon capacity ground storage water tank, and associated piping, wiring and controls and site work including clearing and grading, fencing, access road, other improvements and associated appurtenances as shown on the Contract Documents or described in the Specifications in Bradley County, Tennessee.
