

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Owner: City of Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia

Separate sealed Bids for furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appurtenances necessary for the Upgrade of the Battlefield Parkway Multi-Use Trail SR 2 from CR 58/South Cedar Lane to West Chickamauga Creek will be received by the Owner at the City of Fort Oglethorpe, 500 City Hall Drive, Fort Oglethorpe, GA 30742, until 2:00 p.m., local time, on December 4, 2020, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

This Project is located in Catoosa County, the City of Oglethorpe, along the south frontage of Battlefield Parkway (SR 2) from South Cedar Lane to Fort Town Lane. The Project consists of the following major elements: Construction of a 12-foot-wide concrete multi-use-trail; miscellaneous drainage work, pipe extensions under the proposed multi-use trail route.

Copies of the Contract Documents and Specifications, including bidding documents and requirements, and Contract Drawings may be examined at the offices of the Engineer, CTI Engineers, Inc., 1122 Riverfront Parkway, Chattanooga, TN 37402 (phone 423/267-7613, fax 423/267-0603, www.ctiengr.com). Copies may be obtained there upon payment of \$100.00 for each set. This payment is not refundable.

Bidders must be listed on Engineer's list of planholders who have purchased the Contract Documents, Specifications, and Drawings. The bid package is available for inspection at the Sponsor office located at 500 City Hall Drive, Fort Oglethorpe, GA 30742.

Engineer shall be provided with the following information: mailing address for U.S. Postal Service, physical delivery address, telephone number, FAX number, contact person, and email address.

A Bid Bond of 5% of the total project cost is to be included in the proposal package. The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds with the executed Agreement meeting the requirements of the Contract Documents and executed on the forms attached to the Agreement. The terms and time for payment are set forth in the Agreement.

Performance and Payment Bonds are required as per Section 103.05. For TE projects, the bonds can be Performance Bond 100% of the contract amount and the Payment Bond 110% of the contract amount.

Surety and insurance companies must have an AM Best rating of A-10 or greater, be listed in the Federal Registry of Companies holding Certificates of Authority and Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds, be licensed by the Georgia Insurance Department and the Georgia Secretary of State to do business in the State of Georgia.

Contractor must have minimum Worker's Comp and General Liability Insurance in full force and effect. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91, all contractors and sub-contractors performing work within the State of Georgia on a contract with a public employer must register and participate in a federal work authorization. Fort Oglethorpe will require certification from contractor that this requirement has been met.

GDOT Standard Specifications Construction of Transportation Systems, 2013 Edition, GDOT Supplemental Specifications Book, 2016 Edition, and applicable special provisions and supplemental specifications apply to the contract.

The City of Fort Oglethorpe in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d—42 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, part 21, Nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The DBE goal for this project is 13%. The completed DBE Goals Form, Federal Aid Certification, and Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act Affidavit shall be submitted with the bid.

Construction time period is 90 calendar days.

No bid may be withdrawn within 120 calendar days after scheduled time for receipt of bids.

There will NO pre-bid conference.

The last date for questions will be November 23, 2020.

The last date for issuing an addendum will be December 1, 2020.

If the Contract is awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest reliable bidder whose proposal shall have met all the prescribed requirements. (Section 103.02)

A preconstruction conference will be held with the Sponsor, Contractor, selected DBE firms, and the GDOT Area Engineer.

Fort Oglethorpe reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals, to waive formalities, technicalities or irregularities and to re-advertise if necessary. The contract between Fort Oglethorpe and the selected responder shall be subject to the payment agreement drawn up between Fort Oglethorpe and the selected responder.
