NOTICE FOR REQUEST FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of concrete foundations for the **Coke Oven Booster Pump Station Replacement** will be received by **Walker County Water & Sewerage Authority by mail by sealed envelope and by email to brandon_w@walkercountywsa.com and apierce@ctiengr.com**, at the office of the Authority, located at 4655 Happy Valley Rd., Flintstone, GA 30725, until **2:00 P.M.** local time on **December 29, 2020**, at which time the Bids received will be opened and read. **Bidders may observe the bid opening on-line through the use of video conferencing software.** The Project consists of site grading, construction of foundations for a prefabricated triplex pump station and backup generator and pouring pump bases after the installation of the prefabricated pump station by the Owner.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office. Bidding Documents are available on as portable document format (PDF) files by email without an additional fee. Alternatively, printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office via mail, upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The non-refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents is **\$75** per set, payable to "**CTI Engineers, Inc.**", plus a non-refundable shipping charge. Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent via the prospective Bidder's delivery method of choice; the shipping charge will depend on the shipping method chosen. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

It is the intent of the Owner to award bid and issue Notice to Proceed within one week of the Bid with foundation construction completed by the week ending January 29, 2020. Pump Station delivery is projected to be February 15, 2021.

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A - Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term "iron and steel products" means the following products made primarily of iron or steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials. The de minimis and minor components waiver apply to this contract.
