Separate sealed Bids for furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appurtenances necessary for Water Treatment Plant Improvements will be received by the Owner at The Municipal Building at 3197 Belmont Street, Bellaire, Ohio 43906 until 2:00 p.m., local time, on Thursday, April 15, 2021, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Contract A: Water Treatment Plant Improvements, the project consists of the following major elements: Installation of two 1,000 GPM air strippers and building, filter valves, filter consoles and control replacement, turbidimeters, flocculator and high service pump repairs, site fencing, and distribution valve replacements.

Contract B: AMI Customer Metering System, the project consists of the following elements: The replacement of existing meters with an AMI metering system.

Contract C: Lead Service Line Replacement, the project consists of the following elements: replacing lead service lines from the water main to the AMI meter.

Bidders must be listed on Engineer's list of plan holders who have purchased the Contract Documents, Specifications, and Drawings.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security, furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders shall comply with the Davis-Bacon wage rates.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small business in rural areas (SBRAs).
