Separate sealed Bids for furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appliances necessary for the construction of the Upper Chaney Woods Interceptor Sewer (Segments 4 and 3) will be received by the City of La Vergne at the City Hall, 5093 Murfreesboro Road, La Vergne, Tennessee 37086 until 2:00 p.m., local time, on April 19, 2022, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project consists of the following major elements: Approximately 6,800 LF of 21-inch and 3,200 LF of 18-inch gravity sewer with manholes, incidentals, and appurtenances including highway and railroad crossings.
