Sealed Bids for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, services, supervision, and necessary appurtenances for the construction of the Potter Place Road NW Water Booster Pump Station project will be received by Cleveland Utilities at their offices located at 2435 Guthrie Dr. N.W., Cleveland, TN 37311 until 10:00 AM (local time), June 15, 2022, and then at said office opened and publicly read aloud. Any bid sent by Fedex or similar company shall be sent to Cleveland Utilities, Attention: Jon Sparkman, PE, 2435 Guthrie Drive, N.W., Cleveland, TN, 37312. Contractor is fully responsible for making sure sealed bid is delivered to Cleveland Utilities by the closing date and time.

The project consists of furnishing and installing a prefabricated duplex water booster pump station (with a 12-gpm per pump capacity); along with ductile iron and copper piping, fittings, valves, control panel (including variable frequency drives), electrical components, and other associated appurtenances within the northwestern right-of-way of Potter Place Road NW in Charleston, Tennessee.
