Sealed Bids for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, services, supervision, and necessary appurtenances for the construction of the Wilkinson Road Pump Station Force Main project will be received by Cleveland Utilities at their offices located at 2435 Guthrie Dr. N.W., Cleveland, TN 37311 until 10 a.m. (local time), November 16, 2022, and then at said office opened and publicly read aloud. Any bid mailed shall be sent to: Cleveland Utilities Water and Wastewater Division, Attention: Jon Sparkman, P.E., P.O. Box 2730, Cleveland, TN 37320-2730. Any bid sent by Fedex or similar company shall be sent to Cleveland Utilities, Attention: Jon Sparkman, PE, 2435 Guthrie Drive, N.W., Cleveland, TN, 37312. Contractor is fully responsible for making sure sealed bid is delivered to Cleveland Utilities by the closing date and time.

The project consists of furnishing and installing the following major work elements: Installation of approximately 2,750 linear feet of 10-inch-diameter HDPE sewer force main (including Michigan Avenue Road NE crossing), along with combination air/vacuum/cleanout vaults, gate valves, and other associated appurtenances from the Wilkinson Road Pump Station located at 175 Wilkinson Road NE to the Chatata Creek Pump Station located on the eastern side of the railroad tracks approximately 1,800 feet northeast of Old Tasso Road in Cleveland, Tennessee.

All bidders must be licensed Contractors in compliance with all requirements of the State of Tennessee Contractor's Licensing Act.

The allotted time for construction is to be 120 consecutive calendar days.
