ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Village of Sebring

Separate sealed Bids for furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appliances necessary for the Village of Sebring Wastewater Treatment Plant Ultraviolet Disinfection Improvements will be received by the Owner at the Administration Building, 135 East Ohio Ave., Sebring, Ohio 44672, until 1:00 p.m., local time, on Tuesday, December 13, 2022, and there will be immediately opened and read aloud.

The Project consists of installation of ultraviolet light wastewater disinfection equipment which has been pre-procured by the Village, miscellaneous structural and electrical improvements, and temporary flow bypass to perform the installation.

The estimated construction cost for the complete project is \$250,000.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Sebring Wastewater Treatment Plant, 900 North 18th Street, Sebring, Ohio, 44672 on Friday, December 2, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. Interested bidders are encouraged to attend.

Copies of the Contract Documents and Specifications, including bidding documents and requirements and Contract Drawings may be examined at the offices of the Village Manager, Administration Building, 135 East Ohio Ave., Sebring, Ohio 44672. This payment is not refundable.

Bidders must be listed on Engineer's list of plan holders who have purchased the Contract Documents, Specifications, and Drawings.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security, furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders shall comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, (614) 644-2239.
