Hiwassee Utilities Commission will receive separate sealed Bids for furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appliances necessary for the "Water Treatment Plant Filters 1 – 4 Rehabilitation and Improvements" project at the Hiwassee Utilities Commission's Water Treatment Plant located at 3973 Chatata Valley Road, Charleston, TN 37310. Bids will be received until 2:00 p.m., local time, on June 1, 2023, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid mailed or sent by FedEx or similar company shall be sent to Hiwassee Utilities Commission, Attn: Christina Burrell, 3973 Chatata Valley Road, Charleston, TN 37310.

The Project consists of the following major elements: Concrete repairs, coatings, and replacing filter equipment/media and filter walkway, and other items as included within the project.

Contractors are required to comply with TCA 62-6-119 as outlined in the Information to Bidders.
