

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Benton will receive separate sealed Bids for furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appliances necessary for the "2023 Benton ARP Water System Improvements" project at the Benton City Hall located at 6496 Hwy 411 North, Benton, TN 37307. Bids will be received until 2:00 p.m., local time, on March 26, 2024, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid mailed or sent by FedEx or similar company shall be sent to City of Benton, Attn: Mayor Joe Jenkins, 6496 Hwy 411 North, Benton, TN 37307.

The Project consists of the following major elements: Installation of approximately 10,700 LF of 6-inch and 2-inch waterline including services and service lines and other appurtenances as included within the project.

Contractors are required to comply with TCA 62-6-119 as outlined in the Information to Bidders.
